Rules of Play for Regular Outings

Tee Play

- Age 15 to 54 **Blue Tees**
- Age 55-64 **White Tees**
- Age 65-74 **Gold Tees**
- **Ladies and Legends Red Tees**

1. USGA rules of golf and local rules govern play.
(Also see local rules score card).

2. You may improve your lie by one club length in **your own fairway** only, no closer to the hole.
3. **Putt out.**
4. When playing under the points format, do not play beyond double bogey.
Bogey -----1points Birdie-----4points
Par -----2points Eagle-----6points
Double Eagle-----8points Hole in one----8points
5. **Lost Ball**--A ball is lost if you cannot find it within 5 minutes. Hit a provisional ball from the spot you hit the lost ball.
6. **Rocks and Root Rule**- If your ball comes to rest on or near some roots, or loose or embedded rocks anywhere on the course, you may take relief up to two club lengths and drop the ball, no closer to the hole.
